2017 TATTS FINKE DESERT RACE BIKE/QUAD ENTRY CHECKLIST

NOTE: Supplementary Regulations are now available. Please make sure you read and understand them.

This document describes the process and information required to enter the 2017 Tatts Finke Desert Race. There are four parts to complete in order to get to the start line:

- 1. Apply online on or after Tuesday 31 January (See Application Requirements below)
- 2. Provide additional information (bike details, emergency contacts, crew, etc.) required online when requested (See **Entry Requirements** below)
- 3. Attend registration at the Start/Finish line (indemnities, licence, Ambulance cover, etc.) on Wed 7, Thurs 8 or Fri 9 June (See **Registration Requirements** below)
- 4. Attend scrutineering with your bike at the Start/Finish Line on Friday 9 June (See **Scrutineering Requirements** below)

NOTE: You must have read and understood the rules and regs of the race before you commit to entering. These are (see links on web site):

- MA General Competition Rules (G.C.R's.)
- 2017 Supplementary Regulations (Supp Regs)
- 2017 Participant Declaration (Indemnity)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Entries will open at <u>finkedesertrace.com.au/enter-online</u> on Tuesday 31 January 2017 at 0900 CST. You will need to pay the entry fee and complete the online form to secure a place in the applications list. The information required on the form will be as follows (all fields are required):

Entry Fee

The bike entry fee of \$650 must be paid at https://shop.finkedesertrace.com.au before you can submit your entry form online. The fee covers race entry, the official race magazine, entry into ALL venues and 2 crew passes which also include entry into ALL venues (including scrutineering, start/finish line, and presentation night). The entry fee does not include the optional extra items like club refuelling which can be purchased online as extras once you have a race number.

When you purchase your entry you will be given an Order ID/Invoice Number which you must enter when you submit your online entry. The reference number supporting your payment will be displayed on screen when a successful payment is processed and will also be emailed to you.

If you are a King of the Desert (past outright winner) then your fee is waived and you should enter 99999 (i.e. five nines) for your payment validation on your entry form.

- Surname, First Name, Preferred Name (surname and firstname must match your MA licence)
- Date of Birth, age (you must be 16 years of age or over at 5 June 2017)
- Gender
- How many Finkes have you done before?
- Postal address
- Phone (mobile preferred)
- Email Address

Bike Details

- Class (See Supp Regs)
- Preferred Race Number
- Bike Make (e.g. Honda), Bike Model (e.g. CRF450R)
- Cubic Capacity (cc)

NOTE: When your application is accepted you will be allocated a race number, your name will appear on the list of entries on the web site, and you will receive emails from time to time relating to further requirements for your entry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

During April we will send you an email with login details to use for the submission of further information required for your entry.

Required Information

The following information MUST be provided at this point:

- MA Licence Number, State and Expiry
- Ambulance Provider, Membership No, Expiry
- Bike Frame and Engine numbers

• Emergency Contacts Details (Name, relationship, home address, mobile)

Other Information (Optional)

- GST Status
- Team Name, Sponsors and Social Links
- Media Contact Preference
- Service Crew Members details

NOTE: The Finke committee organises a number of services to help smooth the way and reduce the cost of competing. These services are all optional but a payment is required to help meet the expense involved. You can select and pay for these services using the online extras form at finkedesertrace.com.au. See Supp Regs for more details. Services include refuelling, gear transport, catering at Finke, All Weekend Passes and Presentation tickets.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Competitor Registration is at the Finke Start/Finish Line Complex. Registration is open from 12.00 noon to 6.00pm on Wednesday 7th and Thursday 8th June and Friday 9th June from 9.00am – 12.00. Competitor Registration is where you:

- 1. sign on for the event
- 2. collect your competitor pack which includes passes, information and general items needed to race in Finke (i.e. wristbands, Tatts stickers)
- 3. produce written proof of 100% Ambulance Cover
- 4. hand in your current MA licence (returned when transponder is handed back)

If you're under the age of 18 years of age your parent or legal guardian must also sign you in.

SCRUTINEERING REQUIREMENTS

Scrutineering is held on the Friday before the Prologue at the Finke Desert Race Start/Finish Line from 5.00pm to 9.00pm. You must bring for inspection your:

- 1. bike
- 2. competition licence
- 3. competition clothing, including helmet, gloves etc.

You will be provided with a transponder at scrutineering.

Check the Supp Regs for full details. All bikes will be impounded until the conclusion of scrutineering.
