

Ridernet User Guide – Purchase a One Event Licence

EVENTS NOT TAKING ENTRIES ON RIDERNET

For Events being run outside Ridernet but you have been directed to Ridernet to purchase a One Event Licence, this document will detail how to purchase a One Event Licence for the event. Registration to the event will need to be completed separately as you will only be purchasing an Event Licence for the dates and not entering the event or classes via Ridernet.

VIA THE WEBSITE:

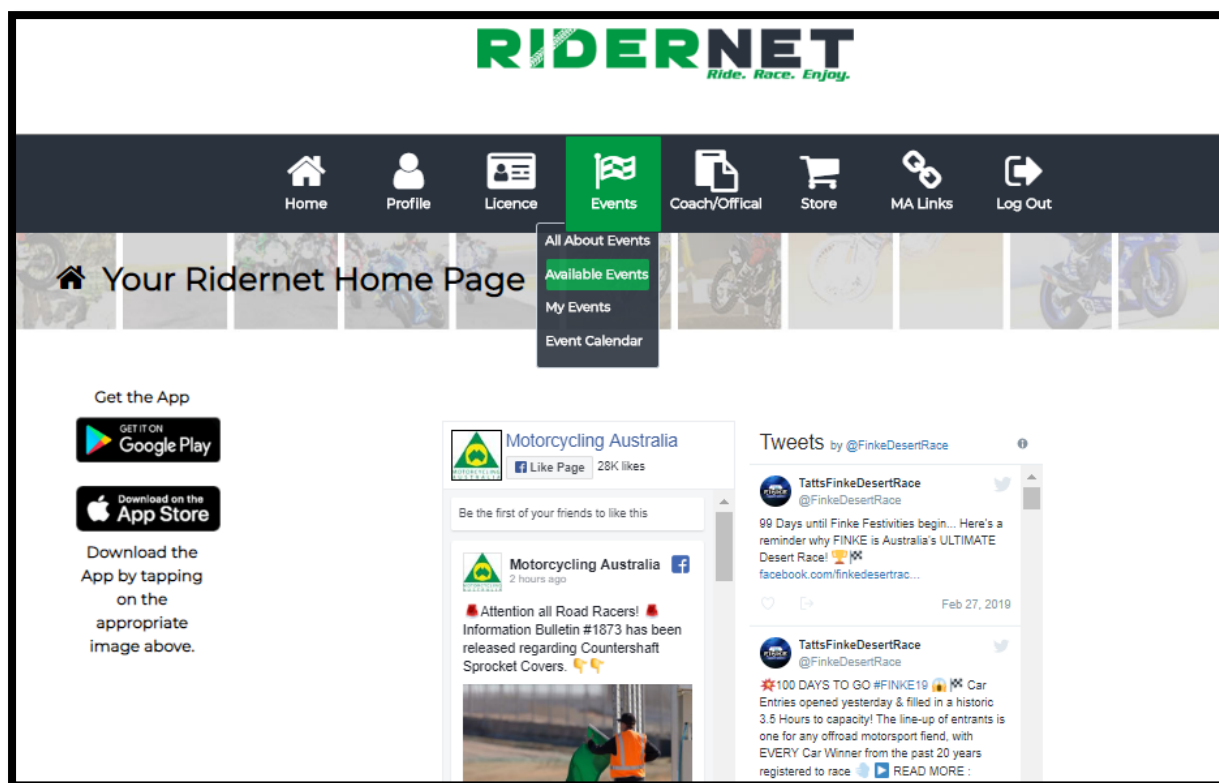

VIA THE APP:

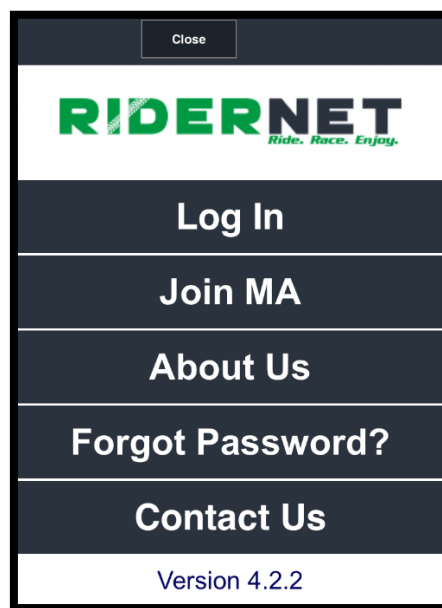

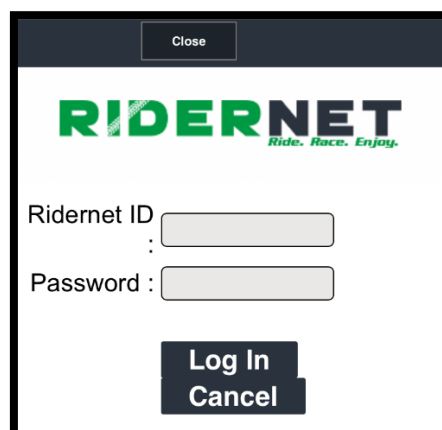

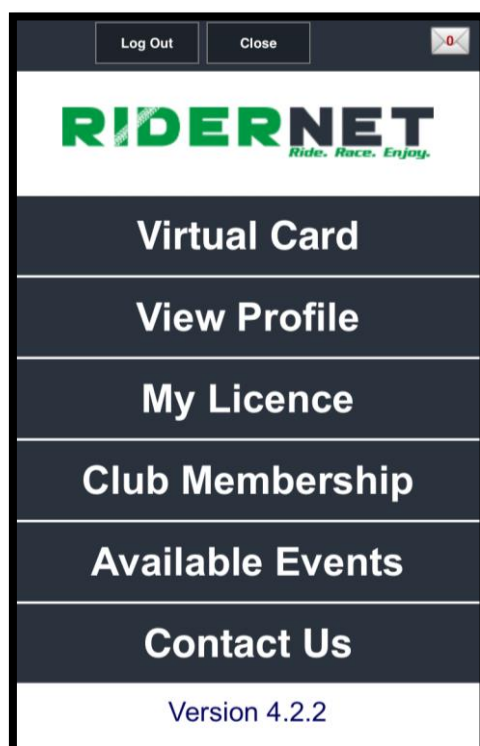
Once you have downloaded the App, open it and select 'Log In'



Enter your existing Ridernet details and proceed with login



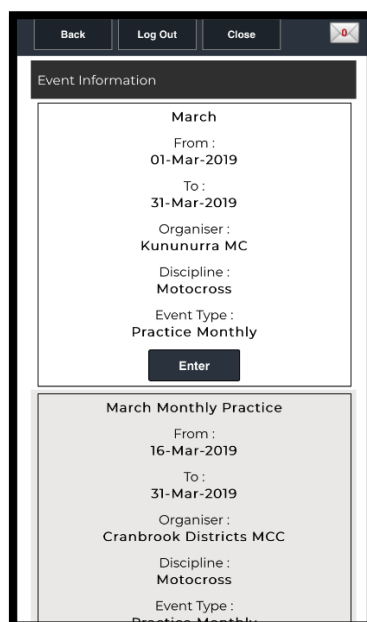
Select 'Available Events' from the menu:


