



2021 TATTS FINKE DESERT RACE

Terms and Conditions to Operate a Food Stall

It is anticipated that up to 7000 people will attend the Scrutineering, on Friday 11th June, up to 6000 will attend Prologue on Saturday 12th June and 4000 people on the two race days (Sunday 13th and Monday 14th June).

The hours of operation for the food stalls are as follows:

- **Scrutineering Friday 11th June** – All stalls must be completely set up from 3pm when gates open to patrons. Trading is allowed anytime from 3pm at the discretion of the stall holder.
- **Prologue Day Saturday 12th June** from 7am
- **Race Day 1 Sunday 13th June** from 6am
- **Race Day 2 Monday 14th June** from 8am

A site manager will be appointed for the duration of the event and will be available should any problems arise. Contact details for the site manager, along with event passes for staff and a site map will be provided the week prior. Setting up of Food Stalls are not to commence before 9am Thursday 10 June.

The decision to appoint food stall operators at these functions will be based on experience, product supplied and value for money for our spectators. A proven ability to meet the requirements of catering for these numbers of people is a necessary part of the application form and will also be taken into consideration

The following conditions shall apply:

- Operators will be allocated a specific site and MUST operate from this position only.
- It is the responsibility of the stall holder to ensure they have NTG COVID-19 Safety Plan. COVID-19 Safety Plan must be submitted by email before your application is confirmed. More info can be found at the [NT Coronavirus Website](#)
- Operators must have relevant public liability insurance and permit/s to operate a food stall. Documentation of such to be included with their online submission. It is the responsibility of operators to obtain the necessary insurance and permit/s and have them displayed.
- You must only provide products for which you have been appointed.
- The expected numbers of people attending these events means we need to be satisfied beyond doubt you will be able to cope with the demand. Considerations will include: relevant experience, speed and quality of service provided, adequate staff resources and the capacity to stock adequate supplies of product to meet the demand.

The site fees are **\$180.00 per site (Friday) and \$150 per site per day (Saturday, Sunday and Monday)**. An additional \$10 per day will be charged if power is required. Fees are payable to Finke Desert Race Inc. by **Friday 28 May 2021**. Site fees will not be refunded for any cancellations beyond this date.

Power – there is a high demand for power and in the past exhibitors have sourced more power than they initially indicated on their application. There are limits to the amount of power available and exhibitors must list the size and number of power outlets they require for their site/s; both 10amp and 15 amp. This assists us with positioning of sites and generators.

Applicants with what the club considers excessive power requirements may be unsuccessful.

All food stall operators will need to adhere to the NT WorkSafe's Guide for Electrical Equipment and Gas Installations at Markets, Shows and Sporting Events.

All power equipment must be tested and tagged in accordance with AS3670:2010. Our site manager will be checking all power equipment to ensure it complies. Where equipment is not tested and tagged, it will not be able to be used.

All food stall operators are required to have an appropriate Fire Extinguisher serviced in accordance with AS1851:2012.

Exhibitors are responsible for the disposal of any waste oil. This is not to be disposed of in the skip bins or left behind.

- Weather – The Finke Desert Race is an all-weather event and the stallholder is responsible to provide their own protection. **The organisers take no responsibility and will not refund site fees in the event of a wash out.**
- Applicants should note that observance of Finke Desert Race Incorporated's commitment to exclusivity for sponsor's product. Successful applicants would need to consider event sponsors in your plans.
- Alice Springs Town Council health and safety by-laws will be enforced.
