

# INFORMATION FOR CAR COMPETITORS

The following Finke Desert Race competitor information provides a guide to riders and crews to help keep our event safe.

## COVID-Safe Behaviours

- How to identify symptoms
  - A recent acute respiratory infection (cough, sore throat, shortness of breath)
  - A fever of 37.5C or history of fever (night sweats, chills)
  - Loss of smell or taste
- Stay at home if you're feeling unwell
- Practice hand hygiene by washing your hands or using hand sanitiser
  - Frequently washing hands with soap and water  
*eg. after going to the bathroom, after handling money, before & after eating and touching face or hair*
  - Avoid touching eyes, mouth and nose
- Practice physical distancing by keeping 1.5m from those not known to you
- Adopt cashless payment methods
- No sharing of bike equipment, tools or apparel
- If more than one person handles equipment, ensure to wipe down surfaces
- Sharing of riding gear such as helmets, gloves and goggles is prohibited

## Registration Process

- Update all details in your online entry including two crew members as is included in your entry fee. Should you choose to have more than 2 crew members, additional crew passes can be purchased through our website – Competitors – Cars – 'Car Crew Extra' link.
- Car competitors will receive the Motorsport Australia declaration form via email to complete and return prior to registration.
- Once at registration, the registration official will check all has been completed.
- A reminder – the competitor must bring proof of Motorsport Australia licence and Ambulance Cover for all competitor and **crew members**.



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## **Scrutineering Process**

- Your self-scrutineering form has been supplied and should have been returned to us by now
- If you haven't returned your self-scrutineering form there may be implications, please contact our office immediately.
- Upon arrival at scrutineering, park your competition vehicle in the designated areas as instructed by officials.
- Race officials will be randomly selecting competitors for in person audit of your self-scrutineering.

## **Driver Briefings**

- Only 1 driver briefing will be held at the event. This will occur prior to racing on Race Day 1. All other driver briefing documents will be communicated electronically.

**Under NO circumstances should ANYONE with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. In the event you develop symptoms over the race weekend please present to the COVID Marshall.**
