Finke Desert Race Work Health & Safety Policy

It is the policy and commitment of the Finke Desert Race Club (FDR) to comply with Work Health and Safety legislation and to provide as far as reasonably practicable a work environment that is safe and without risk to health. The safety of workers, including volunteers, and others involved in FDR activities is of paramount importance to the Finke Desert Race.

The conduct of workers and others with regard to their health and safety at the workplace is one of the highest priorities.

All those involved in any activity associated with the Finke Desert Race will be provided with appropriate information, instruction and education on safe practices and procedures. They are expected to take reasonable steps for their own safety and for the safety of others around them. They will also be encouraged to consult and participate in activities that improve the standards of workplace health and safety.

The Finke Desert Race understands that to reduce the likelihood of workplace injury, improvements through constant information, evaluation and monitoring of the workplace will occur through consultation and co-operation with staff, volunteers, other persons, industry professionals and Motor Sport Agencies.
