BILLY GEDDES GOES FROM ALICE SPRINGS TO FINKE TWICE IN 2014 TATTS FINKE DESERT RACE

Queenslander Billy Geddes is halfway through achieving his epic challenge of competing and finishing the 2014 Tatts Finke Desert race in both a car and on a bike.

This morning he left the Alice Springs start in his #441 Geiser Brothers Trophy Truck with navigator Jamie Ward and blasted down to Finke finishing in seventh position in the car division of the event posting a time of 1 hour 58 minutes and 37 seconds.

Then instead of taking it easy, Geddes jumped aboard a helicopter and zoomed back to the Alice Springs start line again in time to take his grid position in the bike field aboard the #641 KTM 500 EXC.

He has arrived back into Finke after a 3 hour 21 minute and 33 second trip in position 216 in the bike field.

Geddes says he plans to have a long ice bath before sleeping overnight at Finke and then repeating the car and bike feat and helicopter transfer again tomorrow in his quest to be the first person to ever to complete this unique double in the history of the Tatts Finke Desert Race.

Should he be successful he will have covered 904 competitive kilometres in the car and on the bike plus another 452 kilometres in the chopper.
